



Office of Farmland Preservation Sign Policy and Information

Each owner of a farm subject to an agricultural easement by the Office of Farmland Preservation will receive one 18" x 24" steel sign with enamel coating. The sign displays the Farmland Preservation logo and lists the organizations involved in the preservation (ODA, NRCS, and/or the local sponsor). If the farm is greater than three times the average Ohio farm size (in acres), the landowner may request two signs. This sign policy applies to both the Clean Ohio Agricultural Easement Purchase program and the Ohio Agricultural Easement Donation Program.

The cost of the eligible signs will be paid for by the Ohio Department of Agriculture. The landowner may purchase additional signs at the owner's expense.

Such additional signs may be purchased from a sign company of the owner's choosing.

The Ohio Department of Agriculture does not install or erect the signs. ODA encourages farmland owners to consult with the Ohio Department of Transportation and local authorities to ensure that the sign is erected in compliance with any local rules or laws regarding sign type and placement.

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
