

PUBLIC NOTICE

Under authority of Section 921.71 of the Revised Code, The Department of Agriculture of the State of Ohio has placed the state of Ohio under quarantine in an effort to prevent the spread of the Emerald Ash Borer. The quarantine's restrictions are limited to specific areas of the State, designated as regulated areas, where infestation has been confirmed. The regulated area within the Emerald Ash Borer quarantine currently includes Hicksville Township in Defiance County. Infestation has now been confirmed in parts of Lucas County, Ohio. **NOTICE** is hereby given that, under authority of paragraphs (B)(1) and (B)(2) of Section 921.71 of the Revised Code, the following areas of Lucas County, Ohio are designated as regulated areas: all of Swanton Township; the portion of Springfield Township west of Crissy Road; and the portion of Monclova Township west of Weckerly Road, effective immediately.

Accordingly, no person shall move from, within or through the regulated areas any regulated article except in accordance with rule 901:5-56-03 of the Ohio Administrative Code, which may be viewed at the following website: <http://www.ohioagriculture.gov/pubs/divs/plnt/curr/rules/plnt-901-5-56.pdf> or at any public library.
