

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Under authority of Section 921.71 of the Revised Code, The Department of Agriculture of the State of Ohio has placed the state of Ohio under quarantine in an effort to prevent the spread of the Emerald Ash Borer. The quarantine's restrictions are limited to specific areas of the State of Ohio where infestation has been confirmed. These areas are designated as regulated areas. The regulated areas for the Emerald Ash Borer quarantine currently include Hicksville Township in Defiance County; and the area located within the following boundaries: from Maumee Bay West along the Michigan/Ohio border to State Route 109; then South along State Route 109 to the Maumee River; then Northeast along the Maumee River to Maumee Bay, in Fulton, Lucas and Henry Counties. **NOTICE** is hereby given that, effective immediately, under authority of paragraphs (B)(1) and (B)(2) of Section 921.71 of the Revised Code, this regulated area is being expanded to include the portion of Lucas County located east of the Maumee River to County Road 202; the portion of Lake Township in Wood County located east of Tracy Road and north of State Route 795; and Henry Township in Wood County.
