In accordance with OAC rule 901:10-6-01, public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) has issued a final Permit to Operate (PTO) for Ohio Feedlot located in Clark County, Madison Township, at 11000 Huntington Road, South Charleston, Ohio. Owned and operated by Cattle Production Systems, Inc., the facility is in the Little Miami River Watershed.

Ohio Feedlot has a current design capacity of 9,800 head of cattle, which remains the same under the final Permit to Operate. This PTO serves as a replacement to the original operating permit issued by ODA to the farm that was valid for five years.

This Permit to Operate is also valid for a five-year period, at which time the farm owner will be required to apply for a renewal. The PTO is drafted to regulate facility operations with plans for manure management, insect and rodent control, mortality management and emergency response.

The Ohio Feedlot final Permit to Operate can be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC), 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The appeal period ends at 5:00 p.m. on Jan. 4, 2010. A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director of Agriculture within three days after filing the appeal with ERAC.

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
