Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Department of Agriculture has issued Tonnie Schilderink d.b.a. Schilderink Dairy a final Permit to Install. The dairy, which is in Paulding Township and in the Maumee River Watershed, is currently permitted to house 2,990 dairy cows in five enclosed barns. Under state law, if a concentrated animal feeding facility (CAFF) wishes to expand by 10% or more, its owner is required to obtain a Permit to Install and a Permit to Operate from the department. Schilderink Dairy is expanding to a maximum design capacity of 5,410 mature dairy cows.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Department of Agriculture issued Tonnie Schilderink d.b.a. Schilderink Dairy a final Permit to Operate for the entire farm. The final Permit to Operate regulates operations with plans for manure management, insect and rodent control, mortality management, and emergency response. This permit is valid for a five-year period, at which time the owner would be required to renew the operating permit.

The final Permit to Install and final Permit to Operate can be appealed within 30 days to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The appeal period ends at 5:00 p.m. on January 23, 2009. A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director of Agriculture within three days after filing the appeal with Environmental Review Appeals Commission.
