



## Commercial Feeds FYR Spring 2013 Five Year Review

Rules 901:5-7-01.1 to 08 and 10 have been reviewed pursuant to R.C. 119.032 and have been found to need no change at this time. Rule 901:5-7-01 is being amended to update incorporation by reference date, please see below for more detail. The comment period will remain open through April 30, 2013. **901:5-7-01** established definitions to be used in the 901:5-7 chapter. The rule is being amended to update a date reference. Paragraph (A)(1) incorporates the definitions as contained in the 2010 edition of the “Official Publication” of the Association of American Feed Control Officials (AAFCO). This publication has been updated to a 2013 version and that is now the industry standard. The Department is taking this opportunity to remain consistent with the industry. There are no major changes to the definitions in 2013 edition, only minor updates and tweaks.

**901:5-7-01.1** establishes what may appear in a commercial feed product name.

**901:5-7-02** establishes standards for guarantees on labels regarding drugs, minerals, vitamins and moisture.

**901:5-7-03** establishes standards for the ingredient statement on commercial feed labels.

**901:5-7-04** establishes standards for the labeling of commercial feed mineral content.

**901:5-7-05** addresses the manufacture, distribution, and storage of feed; and generally requires that contamination of the product be prevented and that scales used for weighing the product are accurate.

**901:5-7-06** concerns the labeling of commercial feeds containing non-protein nitrogen.

**901:5-7-07** requires that labels be visible and legible.

**901:5-7-08** sets the requirements to be considered an exempt buyer.

**901:5-7-10** establishes standards for the labeling of bulk storage of commercial feed.
