



Rescue Facility Permit Application Instructions

Below is a listing of the required forms to be completed for a Rescue Facility permit.

1. Rescue Facility Permit Application form.
2. A written plan of action if one of the animals listed escapes.
3. A letter from the Sheriff of the county where the animals are held acknowledging receipt of the written plan of action.
4. A letter from the chief law enforcement officer of the township or municipal corporation where the animals are held acknowledging receipt of the written plan of action.
5. If applicable, a copy of the veterinarian's determination that sterilization of any male animals in possession of applicant is medically contraindicated.
6. If applicable, an E-1 form listing applicant's employees.
7. Affidavit regarding compliance with facility and care standards as provided in the Ohio Administrative Rules.
8. Affidavit regarding no public contact with any dangerous wild animals in possession of applicant.
9. If applicable, proof of tax exempt status.

You must have the following on file prior to being scheduled for examination.

1. Properly completed application, printed or typed.
2. Appropriate permit fee. A check or money order needs to be made payable to Treasurer, State of Ohio. Ohio permits are issued annually.

Your permit will be issued if you meet all the requirements.

ALL INCOMPLETE/INCORRECT APPLICATIONS WILL BE RETURNED, UNPROCESSED.
