



Dear Property Owner/Manager,

The Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) would like your assistance in monitoring for the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB), an ash tree-killing insect. We would like permission to use your property as a location for one of our 2009 survey traps. The purple, triangular trap consists of three, 2-foot by 1-foot corrugated plastic panels that are covered with glue and hung in or near an ash tree. The traps are set in the spring, monitored during the summer, and removed in the fall. Trees are not harmed during installation or removal of the trap, but a small branch may occasionally be pruned to aid in installation.

Please note that these traps will not attract EAB to your neighborhood but instead will determine if EAB is already present in the immediate area.
