### **Department of Agriculture Reschedules Clean Ohio Information Session**

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio (Jan. 29, 2009) – Due to the weather, the Ohio Department of Agriculture rescheduled its Clean Ohio Agricultural Easement Purchase Program (AEPP) informational meeting scheduled for tonight in the Wilmington Municipal Building.

The rescheduled meeting will take place on Thursday, Feb. 26, at the Wilmington Municipal Building, 69 N. South St., Wilmington, from 6 – 7:30 p.m., in the Community Room located on the first floor.

The meeting will feature a presentation by the department’s farmland preservation staff as well as testimony from a landowner who has participated in the program. Meeting attendees will also have the opportunity to discuss the program with Ohio Department of Agriculture staff, including the tax advantages involved.

Agricultural easements are voluntary legal agreements restricting non-agricultural development on farmland, with the land itself remaining on the tax rolls and under private ownership and management. Landowners may undertake any agricultural activity permitted under Ohio law, and they can sell their farm or pass it along as a gift to others. However, the easement remains with the land, prohibiting any future non-agricultural development to make certain that it remains used for agricultural purposes.

Clinton County Open Lands, Inc; Tecumseh Land Trust; and Southern Ohio Farmland Preservation Association, all local partners, will also be attending the meeting to provide information and direction to landowners. It is important for attendees to connect with these partners, who submit the AEPP applications to the department on behalf of farm owners.
