## **GOVERNOR, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE DIRECTOR CELEBRATE 5<sup>TH</sup> YEAR OF AG IS COOL**

Current and Past Contest Winners Recognized at the Ohio State Fair

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio (July 29, 2015) – Governor John R. Kasich and Ohio Department of Agriculture Director David T. Daniels announced the winners for the 2015 "Agriculture is Cool" visual arts contest. Ohio children enrolled in school or home schooled during the 2014-2015 academic year shared their personal interpretation of why Ohio agriculture is "cool" for their chance to win tickets to the Ohio State Fair.

Entries, which included photographs, drawings, and paintings, were judged in four different age categories: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12. Seven entries were selected as winners in their respective categories.
