ODA Issues Health Alert for Golden Finger Brand Products

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio (August 7, 2015) – The Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) is issuing a public health alert for Golden Finger Brand Shito products that may have been produced improperly.

The following items are included in this health alert:

- Golden Finger Shito, 8 oz. containers
- Golden Finer Shito, 16 oz. containers

The products subject to this alert were distributed in Columbus, Ohio at the beginning of July, to the following retail stores:

- A Life African Market, 4384 Cleveland Ave., Columbus, OH 43224
- Tadi African Market, Crossroads East Shopping Center, 4415 Crossroads Center, Columbus, OH 43232
- Makola Market, 1470 Morse Rd., Columbus, OH 43229

ODA inspectors discovered the production issue during a visit to the Golden Finger production facility. There have been no reports of illness involving products addressed in this alert, however, individuals exhibiting signs or symptoms of foodborne illness or allergies should contact a physician immediately.
