

Bug Juice International, Inc. issues a voluntary recall on production codes ending in the letter C due to possible health risks.

March 18, 2016- Bug Juice International, Inc. announced today that it is voluntarily recalling product due to process deviations that occurred in a co-pack facility not owned or operated by Bug Juice. The deviations were part of the commercial bottle sorting process and could result in contamination by plastic or metal shavings which could be harmful if consumed. **It is important to note that there have been no reports of illness associated with these products to date.** No other production codes or products are affected by this recall.

There are a total of 46,406 cases that are included in the recall which were produced in February 2016 and distributed nationally . The products subject to this recall are bottles or cases marked with a case code that ends with a "C" (example: 6046 C) and bottle code ending in "OBC" (example: DOB 6046 11:22 OBC) and have the following production case codes:
