## M&L Farms, LLC Expands Voluntary Recall

GROVE CITY, Ohio (July 13, 2017) – M&L Farms, LLC of Grove City, OH announces an expansion of their voluntary recall of approximately 383 beef, goat and lamb carcasses with offal that were produced with a non-potable water supply which failed to meet the Ohio Department of Health's requirements in the Ohio Administrative Code for a private water system. The original recall, issued on July 4, 2017, is being expanded to include two additional locations.

The products subject to the expanded recall include:

- -Whole goat carcasses with heart and liver stamped with the 1 ¾" Ohio mark of inspection bearing establishment number EST. 39.
- -Whole lamb carcasses with heart and liver stamped with the 1 ¼" Ohio mark of inspection bearing establishment number EST. 39.
- -Quartered beef carcasses with heart, liver, and tongue stamped with the 1 3/4" Ohio mark of inspection bearing establishment number EST. 39.

The beef, goat, and lamb carcasses with offal were harvested between June 15, 2017 and June 29, 2017. Carcasses were sold to the following retail market in Ohio for further processing and distribution.

-Salam Market and Bakery located at 5676 Emporium Square, Columbus, Ohio

Additionally, carcasses were available for purchase directly from M&L Farms, LLC located at 5463 Harrisburg Pike, Grove City, Ohio.

Consumers should check with these two locations to determine whether they may have purchased any of the products subject to recall.

The Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) discovered the additional locations during follow-up inspection activities to determine the effectiveness of the initial recall. Customers that have purchased these products are urged not to consume them. These products should be discarded or returned to the place of purchase.
