**Buehler's Fresh Foods, Inc. Issues Precautionary Recall
For Potential Product Contamination**

WOOSTER, OHIO – Buehler's Fresh Foods, Inc. of Wooster, Ohio announces a voluntary recall of approximately 450 pounds of Tasty Steakhouse Chili due to potential product contamination.

The product subject to recall includes:

Buehler's Brand Tasty Steakhouse Chili – one quart containers
Sell by 12/23/10
Manufacture Date: 11/26/10

The product was sold at all Buehler's Fresh Food stores December 1, 2010 through December 10, 2010 in the following Ohio cities:

This recall was initiated after a customer found a piece of plastic in the product.

Because of potential product contamination, Buehler's Fresh Foods, Inc. urges its customers who have purchased the suspect product not to eat it and to return it to any one of Buehler's Fresh Food, Inc. stores listed above.
