Valley Farm Meats Issues Precautionary Recall for Improper Labeling

STRASBURG, Ohio (Sept. 13, 2010) – Valley Farm Meats of Strasburg, Ohio announces a voluntary recall of casing wieners, rope sausage, big bologna, dutch loaf, and ham and cheese loaf due to improper labeling.

The recalled products can be identified by the following Julian dates:

- Casing Wieners Julian Date 0203
- Rope Sausage Julian Date 0207
- Big Bologna Julian Date 0207
- Dutch Loaf Julian Date 0221
- Ham and Cheese Julian Dates 0222 and 0232

The recalled products were manufactured between June 8 and July 22. They were sold between June 12 and Sept. 2, 2010, at Valley Farm Meats, 1317 N. Wooster Ave., Strasburg, Ohio 44680, and Hickory Hill Meats, 144 Groves Ave., Marietta, Ohio 45750.

The improper labeling was discovered during routine inspection by the Ohio Department of Agriculture's Division of Meat Inspection.

Because of improper labeling, Valley Farm Meats asks its customers who have purchased the recalled products to return them to the company. Customers may bring those designated packages to Valley Farm Meats at 1317 N. Wooster Ave., Strasburg, Ohio or call Valley Farm Meats at 330-878-5557.
