**Diamond Crystal Brands Inc. Announces a Nationwide Recall for GFS® Sugar Canisters Due to Undeclared Milk**

November 18, 2011 - Diamond Crystal Brands Inc. of Savannah, Ga., ISSUES ALLERGEN ALERT FOR UNDECLARED MILK in 12-ounce GFS® sugar canisters that were inadvertently filled with non-dairy coffee creamer. These items were shipped in 24-can cases labeled GFS® non-dairy coffee creamer.

Non-dairy coffee creamer contains sodium caseinate, which is a milk derivative. People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to milk run the risk of a serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume this product.

The items include:

CASE LABEL: **GFS® NON-DAIRY COFFEE CREAMER-24/12 ounce - Lot G293 B**

Located on the side of the case.

CANISTER LABEL: **GFS® SUGAR – Lot G293 B**

Located on the bottom of the canister.

The recall was initiated after receiving a customer inquiry.
